

**THE PRAIRIE WIND CASINO**, a business enterprise of the Oglala Sioux Tribe, is governed by a gaming compact that contains a limited waiver of sovereign immunity limited to bodily injuries covered by insurance. However, that waiver does not apply in this case.


**THEREFORE**, this case is dismissed because the Oglala Sioux Tribe has not waived its sovereign immunity and has not agreed to be sued in this case.
