- 4. Never during my tenure as tribal counsel for the Lower Sioux Indian Community was any Community Council member subjected to a removal proceeding or any other penalty for any of the conduct alleged in the removal complaints against Plaintiffs.

From my work with the Lower Sioux Indian Community, including my opportunities to review the history of the Community and the development of its laws since its inception as a tribe in 1936, I am aware of no effort during the entire history of the Lower Sioux Indian Community to remove a council member from office or otherwise impose a penalty upon a council member for any of the conduct alleged in removal complaints against Plaintiffs.
