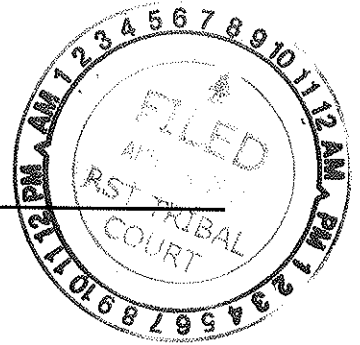

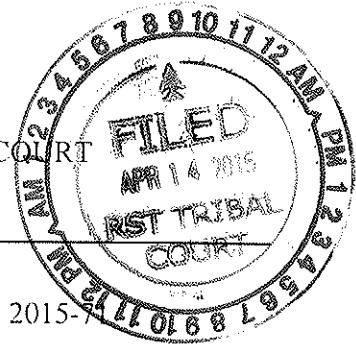

ORDER

Defendant's motion to dismiss Plaintiff's Complaint; for judicial notice of certain pleadings; and Plaintiff's motion for a restraining order came on for hearing on April 3, 2015. Plaintiff appeared in person and through his attorney, Gary Montanna, and Defendant's appeared in person and through their attorney, Steven Sandven. At the beginning of the hearing Plaintiff made an oral motion to sequester all of the Defendants on the grounds that he had subpoenaed them as witnesses, however, because the witnesses were also parties to the lawsuit the Court denied Plaintiff's oral motion to sequester. The Court heard the arguments of counsel and allowed the parties to call witnesses and based upon the pleadings submitted by the parties, the arguments of counsel and testimony of the witnesses, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Plaintiff's complaint against the Defendant is, both individually and in their official capacity, is dismissed on the grounds of sovereign immunity; it is further

ORDERED that the ex parte temporary restraining order granted by the Court dated March 14, 2015, and continued by Order dated March 16, 2015 is dismissed; it is further


ORDERED that Defendant's motion to take judicial notice is granted; it is further

Defendant will be held in abeyance; it is further
