

It is my understanding that the Election Board has been made aware of the fact that Mr. White Plume has a conviction in his record for an assault. Even if this conviction was for a misdemeanor it is classified as a "dishonest act" crime under various Tribal laws. As a result, the Election Code says that he cannot be a candidate and therefore cannot hold office.

It has also been noted that on his sworn application for becoming a candidate, he asserted that he did not have any convictions. If this is the case, it would be grounds for disqualification under the code, as this would constitute perjury.

The Election Board would be justified in removing his name from the ballot, if these assertions are, in fact true.

After review of your appeal the Election Board has made the following decision.

Complaint(s): Dismissal of case in 1982. / Background checks from prior years. / Placement on Ballot

Action(s): Referring to 1982 Docket No. CR82-50039-01, You were indicted with 3 counts of felony violations under 18 USC 1153, & 113(c) and 1 count of 18 USC 1153 & 113(d). You did plea guilty to 18 USC 1153, & 113(d) and were give an imposition of sentence suspension (No prison time) but were placed on probation for a term not to exceed 18 months. This was a judgment and probation/commitment order by the United States District Court of South Dakota. Nowhere does it state this conviction has been dismissed, overturned, expunged or pardoned. An opinion by Thomas J. Ballanco is just that, an opinion, facts from the US District Court would have been more appropriate evidence of your stated dismissal. This is your burden of proof.

We can find no evidence that a Federal Background Check was ever done on your person by past election boards dating back to year 2000. There have been state (DCI) and local background checks. Although we found one (1) challenge to your candidacy back in 2000, we can find no records that indicate this challenge was ever addressed in a proper manner or a federal background check was ever done.

Receipt of your November 7, 2006 memorandum is acknowledged. In your memorandum you indicated that the Election Committee decided to continue with the election process for the 2006 Oglala Sioux Tribal General Election in contravention of the Court of Election appeals decision to hold a new primary and general election.

Specifically, you indicated in your letter that (1) many complaints and appeals have not been heard, (2) the Court of Election Appeals ordered a new election due to (among other things) a lack of background checks on all candidates, (3) the court of Election Appeals is a court with jurisdiction over "the election process."

Based on the Court of Election Appeals November 6, 2006 order that a new 2006 Primary and General Election be held and that the General Election scheduled for November 7, 2006 be rescheduled to permit a time frame for background checks, you directed me to "confiscate all ballots and ballot boxes for the Oglala Sioux Tribal Election and to retain them in a secure location until further directions are issued by the Court of Election Appeals or the OST Tribal Council."

Chapter 1, Section 4 of the Oglala Sioux Tribe's Law and Order Code provides that "the regular Indian police force and other police officers of the United States Indian Service shall have authority to enforce all Tribal ordinances . . ."

In 1976, the Oglala Sioux Tribe contracted the BIA police force pursuant to Public Law 93-638, and since that time has operated under a charter approved by ordinance of the Oglala Sioux Tribal Council. Chapter 1, Section 4.1 of the Law and Order Code provides that "there shall be a Tribal Public Safety Commission with the powers provided in Ordinance No. 76-12, as amended, including to the authority to manage the Law Enforcement Program of the Oglala Sioux Tribe in accordance with the provisions of the Code and to exercise such other related powers as the Council may delegate to it by resolution."

Ordinance No. 76-12, as you know, has been amended and the tribal police department currently operated under a charter approved by an Ordinance (No. ____). The Ordinance, created the Oglala Sioux Tribe Department of Public Safety, Inc. (OSTDPS).

The current charter of the OSTDPS provides in section 5 that one of the missions of the OSTDPS is "enforcing tribal and federal law, upholding the Constitution and By-laws of the Oglala Sioux Tribe, and carrying out lawful decisions of the various branches of tribal government - the Oglala Sioux Tribal Council, the Oglala Sioux Tribal President, and the Oglala Sioux Tribal Courts."

The Tribal President's authority is defined in Article 1, Section 1 of the Tribal By-laws, and is limited to presiding over tribal council meetings and carrying out the orders of the council . . . " The Tribal President has no authority to direct the OSTDPS to take action other than action authorized by a tribal council ordinance or by a tribal court order issued pursuant to authority granted in a tribal council ordinance.

Section 3 of the Tribal Election Code established the Court of Election Appeals "to hear all challenges and/or appeals to the eligibility of candidate and voters, and to the election process." Moreover, Section 16 (G) of the Tribal Election Code provides that "[t]he decisions of the Court of Election Appeals on all issues under its jurisdiction shall be final and binding upon the parties. No further appeals to the Tribal Court or Tribal Supreme Court are available."

Although the Tribal Council appears to have divested the Tribal Court and Tribal Supreme Court of jurisdiction to over rule the Court of Election Appeals on election contests, it appears that the Tribal Court and Tribal Supreme Court would still have the authority to determine such issues as to whether the Court of Election Appeals exceeded its

authority under the Election Code or violated the rights of a tribal member under the 1968 Indian Civil Rights Act. See 25 U.S.C. § 1302.


Also, there appears to be a conflict between the Election Code, in which the Tribal Council took itself out of the election process, and Ordinance No. 06-26 in which the Tribal Council ordered the Oglala Sioux Tribal Election Office to proceed with the General Election as scheduled for November 7, 2006, with an amendment that Wakpamni District have a re-election. Whether this action of the Tribal Council is legal or not is for the Tribal Courts to decide.

In regards to your directive to enforce the Court of Election Appeals order for a new primary and general election, and to confiscate all the ballot and ballot boxes, I am going to have to respectfully decline for two reasons:

- (1) The Tribal President has no authority to order the OSTDPS to do something that the Tribal Council or tribal courts has not ordered; the OSTDPS only follow the directives of the tribal council or the tribal courts.
- (2) The Court of Election Appeals, as a duly appointed court to handle election matters, has not directed the OSTDPS to confiscate the ballot ballots and ballot boxes in its November 6, 2006 order. Therefore, there is no court order to enforce in this regard.



Affidavit of Prejudice

I am hereby charging the two (2) members of the court of election appeals Ms. Connie Brewer and Ms. Barbara Jones of violating their oath of office, the constitution, and the ordinances, and added insult to injury by neglecting to properly file their written findings with the Election Board in addition to the appearance of being involved in a bribery scheme and fraud (forgery). Their involvement in these activities conveys prejudice against a fair election.

The facts are as follows;

On Sunday the 5th of November, the OST Election Board submitted our Report and Recommendations to the OST Court of Election Appeals, removing Alex White Plume's name for candidacy for the OST President. The issue presented was whether to place Alex's name back on the ballot or not.

The court members had failed to submit documents as to their eligibility to be Court of Appeals and were instructed by the attorneys not to discuss the case presented and to convene Monday, after completing their paperwork.

Approximately 4:20, Monday afternoon, November 6th, 2006 the court came together at the Old I.H.S. Offices to meet and we received the written findings (Exhibit A) of the OST Court of Election Appeals Judges of their decision to call for a new election. (approx. 5:00pm) Coincidentally, at 4:45 pm our office received a call from a tribal secretary telling us that the Executive Board had cancelled the election.

Herein lies the basis for my complaint;

ENCLOSURE 12

OST Ordinance 04-06, SECTION 23. Rules and Regulations states in part the following:

The following shall be the rules and regulations that govern the conduct of the election by the Board and the Court of Election Appeals:

1. **Strict adherence** to the provisions of the Election Code;

It goes further to state:

2. **Bribery** is expressly condemned and shall be cause for immediate removal from office, in addition to prosecution under section 65 of the Code of the Tribe, if it is found that an election official was involved in a bribery situation.
6. **Improper conduct** by an Election official... shall be grounds for removal.

Any person alleging a violation of these rules shall document and submit the alleged violation in writing to the committee for their action.

The OST Constitution is very specific as to which committee or governing body has the power, the final say! No sub committee, executive board, or court of appeals has the authority to over turn a decision/ordinance passed by a full-seated council!

Ordinance 04-06 gives authority to the OST Election Board to conduct the Primary, General, and Special Elections of the tribe.

Ordinance 04-06 gives to the Court of Election Appeals authority to make decisions final and binding all **issues** (challenges) that come **under** its jurisdiction!

Ordinance 06-26, states to proceed with the general election! (October 30th, 2006)

Ordinance 99-16 defines the clause, "Dishonest Act."

On Monday, November 6th, 2006, the Court of Election Appeals failed to address the issue/ challenge to place Alex's name back on the ballot. To date, the court of appeals has still failed to properly submit a written report to the OST Election office as to an opinion they may have made on November 7th, 2006, well after the election started! And here we go again with my opinion; they are grossly negligent in their duties and their oath! The Ordinance states the Court shall render its decision, ...within five (5) days.

On Tuesday afternoon, November 7th, 2006 the Court of Election Appeals members in question met without the third member and made a decision to reinstate Alex to the Ballot. (Exhibit C) Also on this day they met and rendered their decision to take the peoples voice away and confiscate the ballot boxes and forged the third member's name.

At whose bidding was this done? On November 6th, 2006, (Exhibit D) the individual's signature on this document is not authorized to process an accounts payable for the Court of Election Appeals. **Note the date!** This leads to the appearance of being involved in BRIBERY!

Note the second voucher submitted on November 7th, 2006, for payment again! (Exhibit E) Did they not think we would see the previous voucher or did they believe they that Alex was the final say on pay they would receive? They were readily involved in a scheme to defraud the OST Treasurer's Office and the people! The ordinance is very specific as to the amount we are to receive.

I am requesting that the OST Court of Election Appeals Judges, Ms. Connie Brewer and or Ms. Barbara Jones, be immediately removed for blatant disregard and failure to uphold and comply with the OST Constitution and By-Laws, the OST Ordinances 98-22 & 04-06, and their Oath of Office, for allowing themselves to be involved in a bribery attempt, and for forgery.

Furthermore, this is the only recourse available since allowing them to occupy the Honorable position of OST Court of Election Appeals Judges, taints the OST Election 2006 with prejudice for a fair hearing for any candidate as they have
