Pursuant to an election authorized by the Area Director, Minneapolis Area Office, Bureau of Indian Affairs, on April 19, 1977, the attached Amendment I to the Constitution and Bylaws of the Lower Sioux Community of the State of Minnesota, was submitted to the qualified voters of the Community and was on June 20, 1977, duly (adopted) (rejected) by a vote of 23 for, and 12 against, in an election in which at least thirty (30) per cent of the 64 entitled to vote cast their ballots in accordance with Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984), as amended by the Act of June 15, 1935 (49 Stat. 378).

Dear Mr. Bucholz:

The Election Board is pleased to provide you with an Absentee Ballot, and a Certificate, as per your request so that you might participate in the Secretarial Election to vote for acceptance or rejection of an amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Lower Sioux Tribe of Minnesota which would lower the voting age from 21 years to 18 years; in regular tribal elections. The election will be held on June 20, 1977. Polls will be open at the Lower Sioux Community Hall, Morton, Minnesota on the day of the election from 8:00 A.M., to 7:00 P.M., C.S.T.

Enclosed is an Absentee Ballot, a Certificate, an envelope stamped "Absentee Ballot," and a preaddressed stamped envelope the following directions are suggested:

1. The voter shall mark such ballot and the ballot shall then be folded so as to conceal the marking and be placed in the envelope marked "Absentee Ballot," and then seal the envelope.
2. The voter shall then complete the "Certificate" and place the sealed envelope marked "Absentee Ballot," together with the certificate in the preaddressed stamped envelope and mail it to the Election Board, Minnesota Sioux Area Field Office, Bureau of Indian Affairs, 831 Second Ave. So., Mpls., MN 55402, or have it delivered to the Election Board at the Lower Sioux Community Hall, Morton, MN 56270. Absentee Ballots must be received by the Election Board no later than 12:00 noon, C.S.T., June 20, 1977 at the Minnesota Sioux Area Field Office and/or may be hand delivered in a sealed envelope to the election polls at the Lower Sioux Community Hall no later than 7:00 P.M., C.S.T., June 20, 1977.

Pursuant to memorandum dated April 19, 1977 from Area Director, Minneapolis Area Office, authorizing this Secretarial Election, notice is hereby given that on June 20, 1977 an election will be held to permit eligible voters of the Lower Sioux Tribe of Minnesota to vote for acceptance or rejection of an amended Constitution & By-Laws. A copy of this document is enclosed explaining lowering the voting age from 21 yrs of age to 18 yrs., in regular tribal elections.


You must register in order to be eligible to vote. An application for registration is enclosed. Your registration form must be received no later than May 31, 1977 for your name to appear on the list of eligible voters. If you are over 18 years of age or will be 18 on or before June 20, 1977 you are eligible to register to vote in this election called by the Secretary of the Interior.

Absentee Ballots will be mailed to all who register and each individual voter, not able to be present at the poll, must request an Absentee Ballot by returning the enclosed registration form on or before May 31, 1977 in order to be counted.
